PERU (PE)

PASSPORT & VISA

Passport required:

- Passports and other documents accepted for entry must be valid on arrival.
- Visa required, except for Nationals of Cyprus for a maximum stay of 90 days.
- Visa required, except for Nationals of Cyprus with a normal passport traveling as tourists for a maximum stay of 183 days.

Minors:

- **WARNING!** In accordance with European Union (EU) Legislation, all minors who are nationals of Cyprus will be expected to hold their own passport or National ID Card (where applicable) when departing from Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Romania or a Schengen Member State For details, [click here](#).

Additional Information:

- Nationals of Cyprus are allowed to stay for a maximum of 90 days during any 6 months.
- Visitors are required to hold proof of sufficient funds to cover their stay and documents required for their next destination.

Warning:

- Visitors not holding return/onward tickets could be refused entry.

Health and destination details

- Vaccinations not required.

Recommended:

- Vaccination against yellow fever for all passengers of 9 months of age and older visiting jungle areas below 2300m in Peru. Travellers who will only visit the cities of Cuzco and Lima, Machu Picchu and the Inca trail and some areas west of the Andes, do not need vaccination.
- Malaria prophylaxis: malaria risk (*P. vivax* and *P. falciparum*) exists throughout the year in rural areas at altitudes below 2000m. The 23 highest risk districts are concentrated in the departments of Ayacucho, Junin, Loreto, Madre de Dios, Piura, San Martin and Tumbes. Most *P. falciparum* cases are reported from Loreto. Recommended prevention: B in *P. vivax* risk areas; C in department of Loreto. .
